Subject: TO THE GLORY AND HONOR OF GOD - PART 9

Well, we are beside ourselves excited! We have quite a story to tell and an amazing God to praise. You have to hear it from the beginning.

When BaLeigh first got sick from the Gardasil vaccine, a special Christian friend told me about a Baptist preacher named Thurman Scrivner in Texas who has healing schools. She said we had to take BaLeigh and go. I have to tell you that this was outside of my comfort zone in a huge way and was further outside Kent's. I listened and said we would pray about it. She later told Kent about him and Kent went to his website and listened to a few messages. She also told my mother about the preacher about ten days ago. She was persistent.

Last Monday, Kent was having his Quiet Time and he prayed that God would heal BaLeigh. About 30 minutes later, he walked out onto the sales floor and a man came into the door and walked straight towards Kent. He said he had a "Word from God" for him. He took him to the verse in James about the deacons anointing the sick with oil (which coincidentally our pastor, Brad, had preached on the day before)(and even more coincidentally Kent and I were there because we haven't been able to go very much with BaLeigh sick, but a friend had come by on Saturday and insisted that we let her stay with BaLeigh so we could go to church). The man also took Kent to a verse in Romans. He said that God said we were supposed to go to Thurman Scrivner's healing school. Looking back, Kent doesn't even know if the man knew that BaLeigh was sick He never mentioned it.

On investigation we discovered that Mr. Scrivner was going to be in Brenham, TX down by Houston this weekend. Or we could wait and go to Dallas on March 14<sup>th</sup>. The three of us decided that if we knew BaLeigh was going to be healed we wouldn't wait for three weeks, we would go now. It was a very inconvenient time to go and we were concerned about BaLeigh being able to go on the trip. But we decided that God would take care of all those details. So on Friday morning, I cooked protein for BaLeigh to eat and we packed two ice chests and left town that afternoon. That morning, through 3 different sources, we were given just under \$1,000 to make the trip. This was great as it was given to Kent and he needed the encouragement that we were doing the right thing.

In Seminole, we received a phone call from a past pastor, Marty Akins. He knew what we were doing and wanted to pray with us. He was so precious as he understands the pain of not being able to fix your child's life threatening situation. He prayed that even as we traveled, we would feel the Holy Spirit fill our car and that BaLeigh's healing would begin. We began to feel a change then. I could feel the difference in the car. We played praise and worship music and BaLeigh sang with it. I haven't heard her sing in a couple of months.

We stayed Friday night in Temple, TX. We tried to get a room at a Holiday Inn Express and couldn't get one because their computers were down. So we went on and got a room that ended up having a full kitchen. We could unload all the protein out of the ice chest and cook her protein. Everything about this trip was to be God ordained.

Mr. Scrivner preached for 4 hours on healing verses and how sickness and pain is tied to sin. He told story after story of people being healed. He was a Baptist deacon who started studying God's Word on healing and learned things that weren't taught in the church. He began to have healing schools and people were being healed. He now has his own church in Dallas and a ministry where he travels around giving these schools. BaLeigh has not been able to be around

groups of people of any size since she got sick. She gets dizzy and sick to her stomach and feels that she will pass out. She felt none of this during the service.

We went up for prayer after the school. BaLeigh had not eaten in 6 hours. She would normally be very sick, having seizures, throwing up, and be horizontal if she had not eaten in that period of time. But she was fine. She had a slight headache and her knee hurt. We were the one of the last people for him to pray for. We talked for a while and he said that we had sinned by fearing the cervical cancer and that Kent and I needed to confess our sin and ask for forgiveness. We had already done that. Kent had begun to feel that way prior to today. We chose to do the vaccine knowing that BaLeigh was not sexually promiscuous, but because she might marry someone who had been and he could bring I-WV into the relationship. That is what the doctor had told us and that made sense. Kent had begun to feel that we didn't have faith that God would bring BaLeigh the best for her marriage partner. I know this is all crazy to many of us and outside of our comfort zone. We talked about any unconfessed sins in our lives, which the three of us had already prayed about together. Mr. Scrivner and his wife prayed over BaLeigh, along with Kent and I. BaLeigh said that she felt a tremendous power come over her body and she even stepped back a couple of times. She started crying and shaking. When he was finished, her headache was gone and her knee no longer hurt. She was the BaLeigh that we have missed so much. She was healed!!!!

So, we went and had Mexican food, because it's her favorite and she had not had it since Christmas. She kept it down – no problem. Tomorrow, we are going for ice cream, which she has never had in her life because of food allergies.

If you will listen carefully to the voice of the LORD your God and do what is right in His sight, obeying His commands and keeping all His decrees, than I will not make you suffer any of the diseases I sent on the Egyptians; for I am the LORD who heals you. Ex. 15:26

Mark 16 says that miraculous signs will accompany those who believe, including drinking anything poisonous and it not hurting them. Gardasil is poison to our girls' bodies.

Then Jesus said to the disciples, "Have faith in God. I tell you the truth, you can say to this mountain, 'May you be lifted up and thrown into the sea,' and it will happen. But you must really believe it will happen and have no doubt in your heart. I tell you, you can pray for anything, and if you believe that you've received it, it will be yours. Mark 11:22-24

All of your prayers have played a part in this healing. Please know that our family has appreciated them so much. The church staff came over and anointed BaLeigh with oil and it was such a special time. The healing began then. It's still very hard to believe that this trial is over by God's grace. It's been three long months. We are still trying to process everything. But one thing we know — GOD HEALED OUR DAUGHTER AND WE HAVE HER BACK! Praise His NAME!
